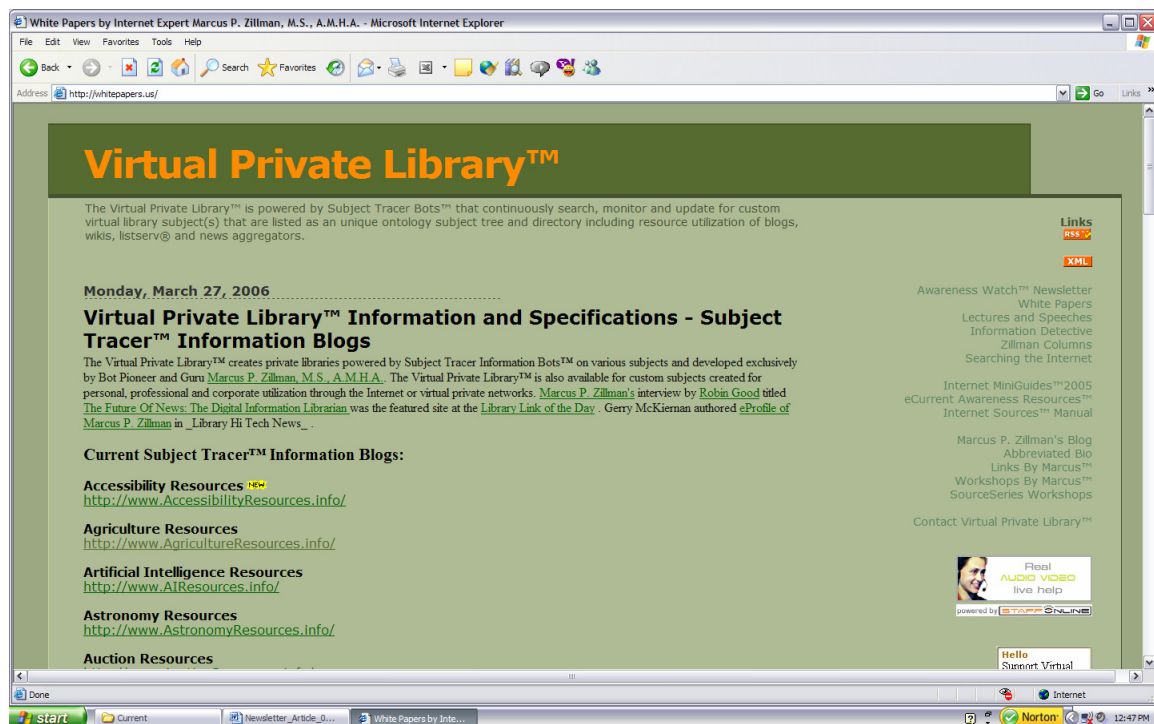


Figure 2 Virtual Private Library™
